

DISCLOSURE OF EDUCATION RECORDED ALTH AND SAFETY EMERGENCIES

If the university determines that there is articulable and significant threat to the health or safety of a student or other individuals, FERPA allows disclosure of information from education redords propriate parties whose knowledge of the information is necessary to protect the health and safety of the student or other individuals.

- x "Articulable and significant threat" means that if a school official can explain why, based on all the information then available, he or shreasonably believes that a student poses a significant threat, as a threat of substantial bodily harm, to any person, including the student threat discussive education records to any person whose knowledge of information from those records will assist in protecting a person from that threat.
- x "Appropriate parties" include parents of the student; parents may be notified when there is a health or safety emergency involving their son or daughter.

In makinga determination to disclosenformation, the universitymay take into account the totality of the circumstances pertaining to a threat to the safety or health of the student or other individalsemergency can be related to the threat of an actual, impending, or imminent emergency, such as a terrorist attack, a natural disaster, a campus shooting, or the outbreak of an epidemic suchcals eAn emergency can also be a situation in which a student gives sufficient, cumulative warning signs that leadtheol officiato believe the student may harm himself or others at any moment.

The FERPAecordkeeping requirements equire the university to record 1) the articulable and significant threat that formed the basis for the disclosure and the parties to whom the information was disclosed his record will demonstrate what circumstances led to the determination that a health or safety emergency existed bowthe disclosure was justified The record must be made within a reasonable period of time after the disclosure made. The record must be maintained with the education records of the student for as long as the student's education records are maintained After disclosing information under the FERPA health and safety exception, document the following information and forward the record to the vice chancell for student services (affairs.

- x Student's Name
- x To whomdid the student pose a significanthreat to health or safety?
- x Articulatethe significant threat to health osafety
- x Describe the circumstances and thise formation available (including relevant dates)
- x Identify theinformation that was disclosed

Name(s) of person(s) to whom thenformation was disclosed
(person whose knowledge the information would assist in protecting person from the threat; or parents)

¹ Note: The FERPA health and safetyuirements donot applyto disclosures to a University of Alaska employee with a legitimate educational interest in the information. Information from education records may be disclosed to a University employee if the information is necessary for that employee to perform work appropriate to his or her position.
